The district has kept the levy right around or under 60 cents for the last 8 budget cycles and at the same time making many improvements to district facilities, including a new addition to the Dodge Elementary Building.

The Howells-Dodge Board of Education is very supportive in the continuation of providing a quality education for the children of the district while maintaining fiscal responsibility.
